The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 536-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 26th August, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

In this application the prayer is for a direction to the respondent to consider his application for compassionate employment. The father of the applicant died in harness on 30.04.2010 working as Group-D staff under the Health & Family Welfare Department. Soon after the death, the applicant applied for compassionate employment on plain paper on 07.06.2010 and in proforma on 17.06.2010. From the record, it appears that the application was processed and Three Men Enquiry Committee also recommended the case. Submission by the learned advocate for the applicant is that a direction to the respondents to consider this long pending proposal and offer a suitable employment under the compassionate employment scheme.

Mr. Roy submits that if such direction is given, the respondent will consider the matter and dispose of the same at

the earliest.

Having heard both the learned advocates, the application is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 2, Director of Health Services, W.B. to consider the application for compassionate employment submitted in the year 2010 which was enquired and recommended in the year 2012 after passing a reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks and communicate the same to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter.

Accordingly, this matter is disposed of.
