Mr. Mukherjee submits that applicant's father Mohan Baskey was a Group-D absorbed by the above order, hence his legal heir is entitled for family pension. However, Mr. Mukherjee has not submitted any document which proves that the applicant's father was one of the 1335 workers absorbed as Group-D, as per Order dated 24.03.2005.

Mrs. Agarwal submits that in the impugned order dated 08.07.2016, where the name of the applicant's father Mohan Baskey is also mentioned, makes it very clear that he was not a regular employee. In fact, his application for compassionate employment was rejected by the said impugned order on the ground that Mohan Baskey was not a regular employee. Mrs. Agarwal also brings to notice the G.O. dated 06.07.2000. Relevant portion is as under :-

“The Govt. will not agree for compassionate appointment in respect of Died in harness Case of Resham Karmee as these posts are supernumerary and these posts will depute as and when Resham Karmee dies and retires.”

Mr. Mukherjee prays for time to submit the relevant

document mentioning Mohan Baskey was one of the 1335 absorbed Group-D employees.
