The present application in terms of section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 inter alia praying for a direction upon the respondents to grant arrear and regular family pension in favour of the physically challenged 1<sup>st</sup> applicant has been filed to secure redressal of grievances.

The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the case is extremely urgent, for which, the matter is required to be placed before the Bench for consideration of the interim relief, otherwise, the entire application will become infructuous.

Perused the application along with all annexure hereinafter referred to as the “said application”.

Considering the nature of substantive and interim relief as prayed for, the said application is required to be served upon the respondents to enable them to controvert the allegations, and or, statements made therein.
