In this application, the applicant – Ananda Kumar Pramanik was a 'Barber' working in the Lalgola Special Jail, on casual basis thrice a week and on "no work no pay" basis. He was appointed on 13.04.1982 and superannuated on 30.06.2019, after putting in his service as the Barber of Lalgola Special Jail for 37 years.

In this application, the prayer is for sanction of  $\gtrless$  3 (Three) Lakh as terminal benefit under Memorandum No. 1033-F(P<sub>2</sub>) dated 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. The relevant portion of this Memorandum is: "With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2019 such workers, on attaining the age of 60 years will be entitled to one time terminal benefit of  $\gtrless$ 3.00 Lakh in place of existing  $\gtrless$ 2.00 Lakh."

It is clear and not in dispute that the applicant was appointed and worked as a "Casual Worker" for 37 years and is eligible for benefit under the Memorandum. Hence, there is merit in this application. Let Respondent No. 3, the Inspector General of Correctional Service, West Bengal be directed to dispose of his prayer by sanctioning the Terminal Benefit of ₹3.00 Lakh as per Memorandum of the Finance Department as stated above within 6 (Six) weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of this order downloaded from the website of the Tribunal.
