The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

With the consent of both the parties, matter has been taken up for hearing. .

The instant application has been filed praying for a direction upon the respondent authorities for compassionate appointment.

The counsel for the applicant has submitted that the father of the applicant was a Resham Karmee working under Assistant Director of Textiles (Sericulture) Uttar Dinajpur who died on 02.06.2013.

The counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice his purpose if the competent authority would be directed to consider his prayer and dispose of the same within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the respondent has no objection to such proposition.

Having heard the parties and perused the materials on record, I direct the Secretary, Department of Agriculture to dispose of the matter regarding compassionate appointment of the applicant after considering the representation, considering the documents submitted in

Accordingly, OA is disposed of with no order as to costs.
