In this application, the applicant has prayed for a direction to the respondents to release her family pension. The employee, the applicant's husband was a Khalasi under the Irrigation & Waterways Department. On 01.05.1997 his service was regularised and he retired on 31.03.2005. Since the length of total service is only 7 years and 11 months, therefore, he was not sanctioned pension.

Learned advocate for the applicant submits although his service was regularised in the year 1997, however, he had been in service in the department since 1981. Therefore, he submits that to qualify him for pension, his past service since 1981 should also be counted.

The counsel for the applicant also submits that he has referred one Judgement of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta reported in 2014, Vol. 3 CHN (Cal) 608. The counsel for the applicant has also submitted written notes of statement. Let those be kept on record.

Let the matter appear for hearing on **23.11.2022**.
