The instant application has been filed praying for following relief :

- 1) To direct the respondent to record the name of the applicant in the service book of the private respondent as she is the wife and legal heir and representative of the private respondent.
- 2) To direct the respondent to consider the representation of the applicant dated 15.02.2019.
- 3) To direct the respondents to produce the record of the said case before this Hon'ble Court.
- 4) To pass such further or other order or order as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper.

During the course of hearing, the counsel for the applicant has fairly submitted that during the pendency of the instant application, her husband died on 27.08.2020. However, she has further submitted that the applicant has filed another application being No. OA-291 OF 2021 praying for compassionate appointment challenging the rejection order of the respondents after the death of her husband.

Mr. G. Halder, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the state respondents has submitted that since the husband of the applicant died in the meantime, therefore, the prayers of the applicant has become infructuous.

Heard the parties and perused the records. It is noted that the main prayer of the applicant in the instant application is to direct the

respondents to put the name of the applicant in the service book of the deceased employee on the basis of the Hon'ble High Court's order passed in CRR 2713 of 1997 dated 09.05.2000. Since the husband of the applicant has died in the meantime and the applicant has already filed another application challenging the rejection order of the compassionate appointment by the respondents, therefore, in our opinion the application has become infructuous. Accordingly OA is disposed of being infructuous.
