Though the matter has appeared under the heading “To Be Mentioned” it is submitted by Mrs. S. Mitra, learned advocate for the applicant since the issue is related to the entitlement of the applicant regarding salary for the leave period from 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 to 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, the matter may be taken for hearing today to which Mr. G. P. Banerjee, learned advocate for the State respondents does not oppose.

In the application, Sefali Adhikary – the applicant, has prayed for several reliefs, the relevant portion of which is as under :

*“(A) Do issue mandate upon the respondents, their men and agents and each of them to forthwith release and pay her entitled amount of salary for the said leave period from 1.12.2018 to 10.6.2019, if required by granting Extra Ordinary Leave, with 18% Interest on the said total sum and forthwith pay the entitled amount of her entitled yearly Increment for the said period and the Bonus amount for the entitled period, as have been paid to other employees, with 18% Interest on the said total sum; .....*”

It is submitted by Mrs. Mitra that though the applicant has

sufficient leave to her credit for the period in question and has been deprived of the salary from 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 to 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 and though a representation dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2019, being annexure-‘B’ to the application, was submitted before the Commandant, State Armed Police, 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion, Krishnanagar, Nadia, being annexure-‘B’ to the application, as no steps have been taken, aggrieved the application has been filed.

Mr. Banerjee submits, if directed, the respondent authorities will consider the matter in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned advocates for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the application is disposed of by directing the Commandant, State Armed Police, 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion, Krishnanagar, Nadia, – the respondent no. 5, to dispose of the representation dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 by passing a reasoned order to be communicated to the parties within fifteen weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of this order downloaded from the website of the Tribunal after giving an opportunity of hearing to the applicant, after verifying the records and after making necessary enquiry.

Since for circumstances beyond control, the Registry is unable to furnish plain copies of this order to the learned advocates for the parties, the Registry is directed to upload this order on the website of the Tribunal forthwith and parties are directed to act on the copies of the order downloaded from the website.
