The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Subsequently, he made representation before the authority for compassionate appointment on 04.04.2018 and subsequently his case was forwarded to the Assistant Secretary to the Govt. of West Bengal, Home & Hill Affairs Department (police Establishment Branch) vide letter dated 08.02.2019 by the D.G.& I.G. of Police, W.B. However, till date no final decision has been communicated to him. Therefore, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice his purpose if the competent authority would be directed to take final decision in this regard within a stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the respondent has no objection for such proposition.
