The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11th February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

With the consent of all the parties, matter has been taken up for hearing.

Today, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that till date she has not received any family pension. It is noted that on 06.01.2022 on the basis of the Memo dated 24.12.2021, issued by the District Inspector of Schools(Primary Education), Nadia to the Deputy Director of School Education (Administration), it has been stated that they have resubmitted the pension papers to the A.G.W.B.

After hearing all the parties, it is directed to the District Inspector of Schools (Primary Education), Nadia with regard to the submission of a detailed status report with regard to service book and the concurrence of Finance Department before the A.G.W.B.

However, today the counsel for the respondent is not in a position to submit whether such direction has been complied with or not. The departmental representative of A.G.W.B. has submitted that they have again asked for clarification from the D.I. of Schools (P.E), Nadia vide letter date 11.03.2022.

In view of the above, D.I. of Schools (P.E), Nadia Respondent No. 2 (iii) is directed to file a status report with regard to the payment of family pension of the applicant by the next date failing which he should be present
