Mrs. Mitra submits that the representation of the applicant for condonation of shortfall to qualifying service was considered by the Respondent No. 2, Director of Personnel and was also referred to the I & W Deptt. However, it appears that the reasoned order of the Director of Personnel in page No. 116, has neither accepted nor rejected the prayer.

Submission is that the Respondent No. 1, Principal Secretary, I & W Deptt. may be directed to consider the prayer of the applicant for condonation of the shortfall of qualifying service as per law and pass a reasoned order.

Mr. Ghosh submits that he has already stated in his reply that the applicant was not a permanent employee and is not entitled for pension due to his nature of work. However, if direction is given, the respondent will consider and dispose of the prayer of the petitioner as per law.

Mr. Mitra appearing on behalf of the Pr. A.G.W.B. has no say in this matter at this juncture.
