The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.- II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels, the matter is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

By way of a supplementary affidavit, the applicant has attached a copy of the representation dated 28.11.2022 filed by the applicant before the Respondent No. 4, Superintendent of Police (Govt. Railway Police), Siliguri. Attention has been drawn by Mr. Singh, learned counsel for the applicant to this representation in which it appears that the applicant has requested the respondent to reconsider the dismissal order in view of the fact that the criminal case in which he was involved has been closed after acquittal.

Mr. Roy, learned counsel submits that if a direction is given to the respondent to consider his representation, the State has no objection.

In view of the above submissions, this application is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 4, Superintendent of Police (Govt. Railway Police), Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling to consider the representation filed by the applicant dated 28.11.2022 before him in accordance with law and dispose of the same within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order.

As prayed for, liberty is also given to file similar

representation before Respondent No. 3, D.I.G. of Police, (Govt. Railway of Police), Kolkata.

It is to be recorded that I have not gone into the merits in this case and all facts are left open for the respondents to interpret. Accordingly, OA is disposed of.
