Mr. Mukherjee has stated in his application for review of the order dated 04.04.2022 that "it is crystal clear that the delay of 07 (seven) years in filing the OA-739 of 2018......have been rejected with a casual approach does not corroborate the facts."

In the order dated 04.04.2022, the Tribunal had rejected the prayer for condonation of delay for seven years for approaching the Tribunal since the death of the employee on 24.03.2011. It was an order based on the simple fact that the applicant took seven years to approach the Tribunal.

During the submission for review of the order dated 04.04.2022, Mr. Mukherjee has failed to satisfy the Court why the order was issued with casual approach.

On the other hand, Mr. Roy has quoted the relevant sections of the CPC and the Tribunal's Act to support his contention that this application for review of the Tribunal's order is not maintainable under law. Therefore, this may be refused.

Having heard both the learned advocates, I am of the opinion that the learned counsel for the applicant has not
