	Mr. S.N. Ray, learned advocate appearing for	
	the State respondents submits that pursuant to the order	
	dated 8 <sup>th</sup> July, 2009 passed in W.P. No. 635(W) of 2006,	
	the Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Water	
	Resources, Investigation & Development Department, the	
	respondent no. 1 under memo dated 19 <sup>th</sup> November,	
	2010, had passed an order for appointment of the	
	applicant. Appointment was granted. Having secured the	
	benefit of the order passed by the High Court, the
