Basu, Learned Advocate.</p> <p>The contemnor has not submitted the report of compliance as directed by this Tribunal on March 6, 2018. By producing a copy of letter dated May 4, 2018 issued by one P. Raha, OSD &amp; Ex-Officio Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Home &amp; Hill Affairs, Government of West Bengal, Mr. Basu, Learned Counsel representing the contemnor contends that the matter has been referred to the Labour Department, but no response has yet been received in connection with the proposal for compassionate appointment of the applicant. We are not satisfied with the manner in which this contempt matter is dealt with by the contemnor. On our specific query to Mr. Basu whether the contemnor is willing to comply with the order passed by the Tribunal or the contemnor is willing to contest the contempt proceeding, Mr. Basu submits that the contemnor is willing to contest this contempt proceeding. We are inclined to give the contemnor adequate opportunity of hearing before invoking the contempt jurisdiction under the provisions of law. Accordingly, the contemnor is at liberty to file an Affidavit as to why contempt rule will</p>
