decision of the contemnor was communicated to the Secretary, Department of Animal Resources Development, Government of West Bengal on March 1, 2016. The prayer of the applicant for compassionate appointment was rejected on the ground of delay in filing the application as reflected from the letter issued by the contemnor on March 1, 2016.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the letter dated March 1, 2016 issued by the Director of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Government of West Bengal (Annexure-D to the compliance report of the contemnor), we are of the view that the order of the Tribunal has been complied with by the concerned respondents/contemnors.

Accordingly, the contempt application is dismissed.
