However, in taking a decision on this issue, the Government as a model employer must be objective and fair with due regard to the provisions of the extant rules, past practices in similar cases as well as public interest. The Tribunal, therefore, feels that it would be proper to dispose of the matter by directing the Respondents, in particular Respondent no. 2, namely, Director of Medical Education and Ex-Officio Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal to consider the representations of the Applicant dated 15-12-2017 and 29-12-2017 and take a decision within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order. Before taking the decision as directed, the Applicant should be given opportunity of being heard. A copy of the decision so taken shall be communicated to the Applicant within three days thereafter."
