issued by the Labour Department, Government of West Bengal, the application for compassionate appointment must be submitted within a period of 2 years from the date of death of the concerned employee. The delay in filing the application was condoned by the Forest Department without having any authority under the law as the said delay can be condoned only by the Labour Department which issued the Notification governing the scheme of compassionate appointment of the applicant.

Accordingly, we are unable to accept the contention made on behalf of the applicant that the delay should not have been taken into consideration by the contemnor in passing the order in compliance with the direction given by the Tribunal. Since the contemnor has taken a decision and the decision has been communicated to the applicant, the contemnor has complied with the direction given by the Tribunal. As a result, the contempt application is dismissed.
