memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 26, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal on verification of office records by passing a reasoned order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receiving the case of the applicants from the Directorate of Irrigation and Waterways, Government of West Bengal and take necessary follow-up action within a period of four weeks thereafter.
