Mr. Learned Counsel representing Bera, applicants submits that the respondents/contemnors of OA 10800 of 1999 challenged the order passed by the Tribunal on April 03, 2002 before the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court by filing W.P.S.T. 77 of 2006. By placing on record certified copy of the order dated July 11, 2013 passed by the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.S.T. No. 77 of 2006, Mr. Bera submits that the said W.P.S.T. No. 77 of 2006 has been dismissed for default and the interim order passed in the said W.P.S.T. No. 77 of 2006 was also vacated.
