	have not complied with the direction passed by the	
	Tribunal. The applicants have also sent copy of the	
	contempt applications to both the contemnors in	
	compliance with the direction given by the Tribunal	
	on July 13, 2018. It appears from affidavit of	
	service filed by the applicants that contemnor no.2	
	accepted the notice and copy of the order and copy	
	of contempt applications, while Contemnor No. 1	
	refused to accept copy of contempt applications and	
	copy of the order passed by the Tribunal. Refusal	
	amounts to good service. So, we are satisfied that	
	the notice and copy of contempt applications have	
	been duly served on the contemnors.	
	Mr. G. P. Banerjee, Learned Counsel appears	
	on behalf of both the contemnors and submits that	
	the State of West Bengal has already filed a Writ	
	Petition before the Division Bench of the Hon'ble
