Mrs. Agarwal, Learned Counsel representing the contemnor has produced one letter dated February 11, 2020 addressed to the Director of Agriculture and Ex-Officio Secretary to the Government of West Bengal by the Deputy Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Agriculture and submitted that the steps are being taken to move Writ application challenging the order passed by the Tribunal in OA-1366/2014. We are not at all satisfied with the submission made by Mrs. Agarwal, as the order of the Tribunal has not been complied with after lapse of almost 11 (eleven) months.
