	2015 and in several other matters by the Tribunal. Since	
	the State respondents submitted that the order dated	
	19 <sup>th</sup> July, 2017 was complied with, the Tribunal had	
	directed the Respondent no. 2 to file affidavit of	
	compliance of the said order.	
	We have perused the affidavit filed by the	
	respondent no. 2, particularly paragraphs 3 and 4	
	thereof. However, we are constrained to say that we are	
	not satisfied with the statements made therein.	
	Mr. S.N. Ray, learned advocate for the	
	alleged contemnor submits that the applicants belonged	
	to the exempted category. The alleged contemnor had	
	sought for names from the employment exchange for the	
	post concerned from the non exempted category.	
	However, the four executive engineers committed a	
	mistake in accepting names from the exempted category

	have apprised his clients about the fate of their	
	applications for appointment. It is prayed that the state	
	authorities should intimate the applicants about the	
	result of their applications.	
	In view of the submission made by Mr. Halder,	
	the Director of Personnel and Ex-officio Chief Engineer,	
	Irrigation and Waterways Department, Jalasampad	
	Bhawan, Kolkata, – the respondent, shall intimate the	
	applicants about the result of their applications within	
	eight weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of	
	this order.
