Ray, [In all the cases] Learned Advocate.</p> <p>The contempt application relates to alleged wilful and deliberate violation of the common judgement dated 19th July, 2017 passed in OA No. 323 of 2015 and in several other matters by the Tribunal. Since the State respondents submitted that the order dated 19th July, 2017 was complied with, the Tribunal had directed the Respondent no. 2 to file affidavit of compliance of the said order.</p> <p>We have perused the affidavit filed by the respondent no. 2, particularly paragraphs 3 and 4 thereof. However, we are constrained to say that we are not satisfied with the statements made therein.</p> <p>Mr. S.N. Ray, learned advocate for the alleged contemnor submits that the applicants belonged to the exempted category. The alleged contemnor had sought for names from the employment exchange for the post concerned from the non exempted category.
