	by the Department of Development and Planning,	
	Government of West Bengal, but the said Department has	
	not responded positively due to non-availability of	
	vacancy for giving birth to the applicant by way of	
	compassionate appointment. The contemnor has already	
	been transferred from the post of District Magistrate,	
	Malda on March 8, 2017. Since the contemnor has done	
	his part of duty for compliance with the direction given by	
	the Tribunal and since the contemnor being the District	
	Magistrate of Malda had no authority to take the decision	
	in connection with the compassionate appointment of the	
	applicant, and since the contemnor has already been	
	transferred from the post of District Magistrate, Malda on	
	March 8, 2017, the present contempt application is not	
	maintainable against the present contemnor. The	
	contempt application is, thus, dismissed.	
	The personal appearance of the contemnor is	
	dispensed with.
