Further, as we have already passed our order making it very clear that the members of the Rogi Kalyan Samity are not civil post holder and thus we do not have any jurisdiction over this issue. Therefore, such order cannot be recalled or restored under Miscellaneous Application. Thus, we do not find any reason to entertain the instant application.
