Thereafter the applicant has filed the instant MA for condonation of delay in filing the original application. As per the applicant, he has no knowledge about the issue of limitation in filing the instant application. Therefore, he has prayed for rejection of both MA &amp; OA.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We have heard both the applications and perused the records. It is noted that the mother of the applicant herself has opted not to apply for the compassionate appointment and admittedly the applicant was nine years old at the time of death of his father. Further the applicant has challenged the impugned order after about lapse of four years.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">It is settled principle of law that the compassionate appointment is not a matter of right. The main purpose to provide compassionate appointment to enable the family to overcome sudden financial crisis caused due to the death of sole bread earner and in the instant case, admittedly mother of the applicant did not applied for compassionate appointment rather the applicant was nine years old at the time of death of his father.
