Having heard Learned Counsel representing the respective parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we find that on February 23, 2016 this Tribunal passed an interim order in OA 190 of 2016 by directing the Public Service Commission, West Bengal and other state respondents to keep the process of recruitment to the post of Joint Block Development Officer alive until further order. West Bengal will be at liberty to complete the process of recruitment for filling up the post of Joint Block Development Officer, but one post in the said cadre will be kept vacant till the final decision of the original application. In view of existence of above interim order we do not think that there is need of any further interim order in the original application. It is crystal clear from the above interim order that if the applicant succeeds in the original application he will get promotion to the post of Joint Block Development Officer and his seniority will be fixed in accordance with law. In view of our above findings, the present MA 67 of 2017 stands dismissed.
