view of the above, we direct the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Director of Integrated Child Development Service Scheme, Government of West Bengal to consider the prayer of the applicant for granting of interim allowances in terms of Rule 14 and to pass a reasoned and speaking order in this respect and if the applicant made representation to that effect. The applicant is directed to make appropriate application before the authority within a period of one week and the respondent is directed to consider the case and to communicate the same to the applicant within a period of four weeks thereafter

Accordingly the M.A. is thus disposed of .

OA-565 of 2017

The counsel for the applicant clearly submitted that he is not pressing for B and C interim relief since he is not getting the pensionary benefits. Therefore the respondent should file reply within a period of 4(four) weeks positively and rejoinder, if any, within 2(two) weeks thereafter.
