	the present case, we find that the Departmental	
	Enquiry started against the applicant has been	
	concluded but the final order has not been passed	
	by the disciplinary authority till date. We also find	
	that the criminal case which was started against	
	the applicant is still pending for adjudication	
	before the competent Court of Law. Admittedly, no	
	interim allowance is given to the applicant in	
	terms of the provisions of Rule 14 of West Bengal	
	Services (Death-Cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules,	
	1971 (in short, the D.C.R.B. Rules, 1971) after	
	retirement of the applicant from service due to	
	pendency of the criminal proceeding against him.	
	Nor do we find that the provisional pension is	
	granted in favour of the applicant in terms of the	
	provisions of Rule 10 (2) of the D.C.R.B. Rules,	
	1971 though the disciplinary proceeding is still	
	pending against the applicant after his retirement	
	from service.	
	Learned Counsel for the applicant submits

In view of our above observations, we would like to hold that the applicant is entitled to get provisional pension in terms of provisions of Rule 10 (2) of the D.C.R.B. Rules, 1971 during the period from the date of his retirement from service till the conclusion of the disciplinary proceeding pending against him. As a result, we direct the Respondent No. 3, the Commandant, Eastern Frontier Rifles, Salua, Paschim Midnapore to take necessary steps for release of provisional pension in favour of the applicant in terms of the provisions of Rule 10 (2) of the D.C.R.B. Rules, 1971 during the period from the date of his retirement from service till the date of conclusion
