The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents for grant of officiating pay of the Head Clerk for a period of 1 (one) month from December 01, 2013 to December 31, 2013.

The contention of the applicant is that he retired from service on December 31, 2013 from the establishment of the respondent no. 4, Superintendent of Police, North 24-Parganas. The further contention of the applicant is that he was working as Accountant in Police Office immediately before his officiating appointment as Head Clerk. He worked as Head Clerk of Police Office of North 24 Parganas for a period of 1 (one) month during the month of December 2013 on officiating basis in terms of the order passed by the Superintendent of Police, North 24 Parganas on December 2013 in anticipation of approval of Deputy Inspector General of Police, Presidency Range. The grievance of the applicant is that he has not been paid salary for discharging his

The representation submitted by the applicant in this regard before the respondent no. 3 on March 15, 2014 has not been considered as yet.</p> <p>Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the background of filing the present application, we are of the view that the representation submitted by the applicant should be considered by the respondent no. 3 in accordance with law within a specific period of time.
