	any regular pension as well as salary and gratuity		
	for the suspension period. However, if the applicant		
	would file any application for ad-interim allowance		
	as per the Rules then the authority may consider as		
	per rules. They have also made it clear that though		
	it is the discretionary power of the authority but the		
	applicant has to first approach the authority which		
	he did not do so. Therefore, the respondent has		
	prayed for rejection of the application. Let the report
