However, it is noted that the mother of the applicant died in harness on 03.02.1995 leaving behind the applicant (Unmarried daughter), her husband as legal heirs. After the death of the mother the applicant filed application for compassionate appointment in her favour. However, as nothing has been done. She preferred OA-249 of 2014, which was dismissed for default on 29.08.14. Thereafter, she made the instant application. It is noted that after the OA was being dismissed for default against which neither any application for recalling of order was filed within time nor any appeal was preferred but straightway the instant application has been filed on the self-same cause of action. Therefore, in our considered view, the case is hopelessly barred by res judicata as well as limitation. Thus, we do not find any reason to entertain the OA.
