	For the Applicant : Mr.G.P.Banerjee Mr.A.Mitra Advocates

	At the very outset Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned	
	advocate for the applicant, submits that since the	
	matter is urgent, the applicant has served copies of the	
	application on the respondents and affidavit of service	
	to that effect is filed. Let affidavit of service filed be	
	kept on record.	
	In this application, Sumitra Banerjee, the	
	applicant, has prayed for certain reliefs, the relevant	
	portion of which is as under:-	
	" (a) An order do issue there by	
	directing the respondent authorities to	
	give a suitable posting at any Nursing	
	Training School (as Senior Sister Tutor) or	
	College of Nursing (as Senior Faculty) in	
	Kolkata within a stipulated time period.	

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	 (b) An order do issue directing the respondent authorities to dispose of the representation dated 21.10.2020 made before them within a stipulated time period after giving an opportunity of hearing to the applicant herein. (c) An order do issue there by setting aside/quashing the Memorandum no. C/143 dated 06.10.2020 issued by the Director of Health Services, Directorate of Health & Family Welfare, West Bengal immediately" It appears that that applicant had joined as Staff Nurse on 3rd August, 2001 under the State of West Bengal. She was promoted as Grade-I(i)b and was detailed to work at "DNS Grade-I(i)b, M.R.Bangur Hospital, Kolkata detailed at College of Nursing, Medical College and Hospital Kolkata." Thereafter by order dated 1st April, 2020 she was detailed to work at M.R.Bangur Hospital, 24 Paraganas (South) as DNS Grade-I (i)b due to emergency situation. 	
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	It appears that the applicant on 2 nd April, 2020	
	made a representation before the Principal College of	
	Nursing, Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata, for	
	the inconvenience causes about accepting the order	
	dated 1 st April, 2020. Ultimately, the applicant on 3 rd	
	April, 2020 joined duties. Thereafter the applicant had	
	absented from duties. It appears on 6th April, 2020 the	
	applicant by a letter has given the cause of absence in	
	duties. Subsequently the applicant has submitted	
	several representations which are on record. It appears	
	that the Director of Health Services, West Bengal, the	
	respondent no. 2 had issued a Memorandum dated 6th	
	October, 2020 directing her to resume her duties and to	
	show-cause why disciplinary action should not be	
	taken against her for the absence. On 21st October,	
	2020, the applicant by a letter addressed to the	
	Superintendent, M.R.Bangur Hospital Kolkata, the	
	respondent no. 5, had requested to allow her to join	
	duties which was granted as evident from Annexure at	
	page 58 of the application. It is submitted by	
	Mr.Banerjee that since the applicant has a three year	
	old child, it is very difficult for her to perform her	
	duties in a Covid-19 designated M.R.Bangur Hospital	
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	Kolkata and for the said reason a representation dated	
	21st October, 2020 has been submitted before the	
	Director of Health Services and Deputy Director of	
	Health Services (Nursing), the respondent nos. 2 and 4	
	respectively which may be directed to be considered	
	sympathetically. Prayer is that in this backdrop, the	
	memorandum dated 6th October, 2020 may be directed	
	to be quashed.	
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	Mr.S.Ghosh, learned advocate appearing on	
	behalf of the respondents submits that since the	
	applicant was absent since 3 rd April, 2020 and has	
	joined duties on 21 st October, 2020, no order may be	
	passed.	
	In reply it is submitted by Mr.Banerjee, that	
	since she has a three year old child, in view of the	
	circumstances as indicated in the several	
	representations, the respondents are directed not to	
	take action pursuant to the Memorandum dated 6th	
	October, 2020, being Annexure-E to the application,	
	and the respondent authorities may be directed to	
	consider the representation sympathetically.	

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	Having heard lear	ned advocates for the parties	
	and considering the facts a	and circumstances of the case	
	since we find that the mer	norandum dated 6th October,	
	2020 has been issued to t	he applicant for her absence	
	and as we find subse	quently the applicant has	
	resumed her duties, in	n such circumstances, the	
	application is disposed of	by directing the Director of	
	Health Services, West Ber	ngal, Kolkata, the respondent	
	no. 2, to dispose of th	e representation dated 21st	
	October, 2020 by passir	ng a reasoned order to be	
	communicated to the	applicant after giving an	
	opportunity of hearing	and after considering the	
	matter sympathetically.
