consideration of the provisions of Rule 36 of the DCRB Rules, 1971, we find that that the State respondents may condone the deficiency upto six months in qualifying service for grant of pension. Since the applicant is deprived of pension due to short fall of 5 months and 24 days in qualifying service for grant of pension, we direct the respondent No. 1, Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Home (Police) to consider the case of the applicant for grant of pension by condonation of short fall of 5 months and 24 days in qualifying service for grant of pension by invoking the provisions of Rule 36 of the DCRB Rules, 1971, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of the order and take necessary follow-up action within a period of eight weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application is disposed of.
