It is appropriate to refer to "Step 11" of the said advertisement which is as under :</p> <p>"If your candidature is found eligible candidate will be intimated by E-mail/SMS regarding the Call Letter for Written Test/Interview. On receipt of the E-mail/SMS candidate will have to once again login to www.wbhrb.in and click on "PRINT THE ADMIT CARD/CALL LETTER" button to get your Admit Card/Call letter...".</p> <p>It appears from page 16 of the application that the acknowledgement slip for recruitment to the post of Drug Inspector along with the bar code number was issued to the applicant by e-mail which she received. Thereafter, as evident from page 17 of the application the applicant got the interview call letter dated 5th April, 2017 with the same bar code that the interview was to be held on 3rd May, 2017. Subsequently, on 12th September, 2017 the applicant filed representation praying to appear for interview for the post of Drug Inspector, the relevant portion of which is as under :-</p>
