	We find that the impugned order contained	
	in the memo dated 9 th April, 2018 does not spell out any	
	reason for rejecting the application for voluntary	
	retirement as it merely refers to Sub rule (aaaa) of Rule	
	75 which according to the applicant is not applicable to	
	him. Moreover, the order is cryptic.	
	In our view the impugned order contained	
	in the memo dated 9 th April, 2018 cannot be sustained as	
	it does not contain any reason and is cryptic and is thus	
	set aside and quashed. Hence the application is allowed.	
	Moreover the issue is covered by the judgement of OA	
	833 of 2018 passed on 16 th November, 2018 which was	
	passed pursuant to the judgement passed in OA 346 of	
	2015 (Dr. Ashok Kumar Maiti & Ors –Vs- State of W.B. &
