pay slip issued on July 09, 2007. According to the applicant, the order of the Tribunal was not complied with and as such the applicant had to approach the Tribunal by filing contempt application (CCP 114 of 2014) which was disposed of November 24, 2015 by observing that there was no provision for payment of DA as sanctioned by Government of India from time to time to the President of District Consumer Redressal Forum and thereby the contempt application was disposed of. Without ventilating his grievance before the higher forum after the disposal of the said contempt application, the applicant again approached the Tribunal for the second time by filing the present application praying for the same relief.

The applicant has failed to produce copy of the letter of appointment for joining in the post of President of District Consumer Dispute Redressal Forum and as such we are in the dark about the terms and condition of appointment of the applicant in the post of President of District Consumer Dispute Redressal Forum. It appears from memorandum dated May 27, 2009 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal (Annexure III to the reply of the state respondent) that the president of District Consumer Dispute Redressal Forum is entitled to get pay and allowance last drawn by him as District Judge and Member of West Bengal Higher Judicial Service minus pension after amendment of Rule 3
