The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to grant him appointment in Group 'D' post after quashing of the corrigendum notice dated July 31, 2010 published in the Anandabazar Patrika. It appears from the materials on record that the Directorate of Irrigation and Waterways, Government of West Bengal made a drive for filling up 1,446 vacancies in Group 'D' category of post under different circles of the Department of Irrigation and Waterways, Government of West Bengal. The Irrigation and Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal had formed 12 (twelve) different sub-committees for filling up vacancies of Group	
	'D' post. The Sub-committees for futing up vacancies of Group 'D' post. The Sub-committee no. 01 was formed under Chairmanship of Superintending Engineer, Eastern Circle. The said Superintending Engineer, Eastern Circle invited sponsorship from Employment Exchange for exempted category of candidates by mistake along with sponsorship from non-exempted category of candidates from the Employment Exchange. On closure of screening process by interview, the combined merit list of the candidates was prepared on the basis of the marks obtained by the respective candidates. The panel for

	recruitment to Group 'D' post was prepared as per 100-	
	Point Roster in terms of Circular No. 240-EMP dated	
	August 02, 2001 issued by the Labour Department,	
	Government of West Bengal, and only 271 candidates	
	were selected for filling up the vacancies in the Eastern	
	Circle under the Department of Irrigation and Waterways.	
	The list of selected candidates was published in the Daily	
	Newspaper on July 24, 2010 and subsequent	
	modification in this regard was published in the Daily	
	Newspaper on July 31, 2010. The State Respondents	
	have clarified in Paragraph 6 of the reply that the name of	
	the applicant Anisur Ali was listed against Serial No. 191	
	in the combined Merit List, but the category was	
	erroneously typed as "Scheduled Caste" instead of	
	"General Category" and accordingly his Roll No. A549	
	was erroneously published in the Merit List in the Daily	
	Newspaper on July 24, 2010. This mistake was identified	
	after scrutiny of the Select List and the same was	
	replaced by the eligible Scheduled Caste candidate	
	bearing Roll No. B134 whose Serial No. was 281 in the	
	Combined Merit List published by way of corrigendum in	
	the Daily Newspaper dated July 31, 2010.	
	With regard to the grievance of the applicant for not	
	getting appointment even as General Category candidate,	
	the Status Report submitted by the Executive Engineer	
	and the Technical Assistant to the Superintending	
	Engineer, Eastern Circle, Irrigation and Waterways

	Directorate on May 05, 2007 indicates that the applicant	
	Anisur Ali obtained 82 marks and the last select	
	candidate in the General category A.K. Das having Roll	
	No. CB906 also got 82 marks. The applicant was	
	eliminated on the basis of seniority in respect of Date of	
	Birth, as the Date of Birth of A.K. Das was July 14, 1965,	
	whereas the Date of Birth of the applicant Anisur Ali was	
	June 22, 1969.	
	Learned Counsel representing the applicant has tried	
	to impress upon the Bench that the applicant Anisur Ali	
	should have been appointed on Group 'D' post as	
	exempted category candidate. In this regard, we	
	specifically asked the state respondents to submit	
	additional reply supported by an Affidavit of the	
	Respondent No. 2, the Director of Personnel and Ex-Officio	
	Chief Engineer, Irrigation and Waterways Directorate. The	
	additional reply submitted by the Respondent No. 2 on	
	November 12, 2018 indicates that the Superintending	
	Engineer, Eastern Circle invited sponsorship in the	
	exempted category of candidates from the Employment	
	Exchange for his circle by mistake and against which the	
	Employment Exchange sponsored 1245 candidates in	
	connection with the recruitment process initiated in the	
	year 2006 for filling up Group 'D' posts. The additional	
	reply by the Respondent No. 2 has categorically pointed	
	out in Paragraph 2 that vacancies of Group 'D' posts were	
	meant for non-exempted category of candidates in terms

	of order of the Irrigation and Waterways Department vide	
	No. 1114-1E/1E/1E-2E-05/2005 dated July 07, 2009	
	and as such no candidate from exempted category was	
	appointed in the Group 'D' post in the selection process	
	initiated in the year 2006. In view of our above	
	observation, we do not find any merit in the submission	
	made on behalf of the applicant that he should have been	
	appointed in Group 'D' post as an exempted category	
	candidate.	
	Since the applicant was not selected on merit for	
	appointment to the post of Group 'D' under Directorate of	
	Irrigation and Waterways, Government of West Bengal	
	inspite of participating in the selection process initiated in	
	the year 2006, the applicant is not entitled to get the	
	benefit of the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme	
	Court of India in the case of "Buddhadeb Ruidas & Ors. v.	
	State of West Bengal & Ors." (CIVIL APPEAL No. 6748-	
	6749 of 2013 arising out of SLP (C) No. 6177-6178 of	
	2012 being disposed of on August 13, 2013). In view of	
	our above findings, we cannot persuade ourselves to	
	grant any relief to the applicant in the present application. As a result, the original application is <b>dismissed</b> .
