Panda Palit as wife, Soma Palit, (applicant no. 1) as daughter, Suparna Ghosh as married daughter and Krishna Ghosh as married daughter. On March 17, 2012 the applicant No. 1 submitted application in the prescribed format praying for compassionate appointment. The application was duly forwarded to the higher authority, but the entire exercise has not yet been completed for taking decision whether the applicant no. 1 is entitled to get compassionate appointment.
