	Alipore on cancellation of reasoned order dated August	
	02, 2013 passed by the Respondent No. 3.	
	It appears from the materials on record that the	
	applicant joined as Geo-Hydrological Assistant at	
	Burdwan on transfer after availing of maternity leave on	
	April 19, 2012. The applicant applied for Child Care Leave	
	( in short CCL) on April 20, 2012 which was extended	
	from time to time till October 05, 2012. The applicant	
	availed of Earned Leave from November 26, 2012 to	
	November 30, 2012 and Commuted Leave from	
	December 10, 2012 to December 21, 2012 . The applicant	
	also prayed for CCL from January 22, 2013 to September	
	27, 2013 and was also abent absent from duty without	
	praying for any kind of leave for about 22 days in the year	
	2012 and in the year 2013. The prayer of the applicant for

	grant of CCL was rejected and the same was	
	communicated to the applicant by letter dated July 02,	
	2012 and letter dated January 29, 2013 . On our query	
	Learned Counsel representing the applicant submits that	
	the applicant went to join her present assignment on	
	April 17, 2017 but she was not permitted to join her post	
	in Burdwan. On rough calculation of the period of	
	absence of the applicant from duty and the period for	
	which leave was rejected by the authority concerned, we	
	are not in a position to assess whether the applicant was	
	absent from duty for the period exceeding five years. It is	
	relevant to point out that leave is not a matter of right as	
	laid down in Rule 153 West Bengal Service Rule, Part –I	
	and we are not inclined to interfere in the discretion	
	exercised by the leave sanctioning authority in rejecting	
	the prayer of the applicant for grant of leave .	
	However, on consideration of the important	
	post held by the applicant and on consideration of the	
	long period of unauthorised absence of the applicant	
	from duty, we are inclined to give the applicant an	
	opportunity to submit a representation before the	
	Respondent No. 2 , Director, Directorate of Water	
	Resources Investigation and Development,. Government
