	The applicant was appointed as Guardsman in	
	the Office of the Commandant, Border Wing Home	
	Guards Battalion and had superannuated on 31 <sup>st</sup> August,	
	2017. The applicant has, inter alia, prayed for "An	
	order directing and/or commanding the Respondent	
	Authorities to consider the application of the applicant	
	and to give him pension and other benefits as he is	
	eligible to receive his pension".	
	It appears from the application that the	
	applicant about forty years back while in service had	
	married one Nandarani Pal in accordance with the Hindu	
	rites and customs and had two children. Due to certain	
	disputes the first wife left her matrimonial home after	
	four years of marriage and started living with her parents.	
	After about two years of such incident the applicant left	
	his wife and married Jamuna Pal on 7 <sup>th</sup> March, 1978. It	
	appears from paragraph 6.6 that since the applicant was	
	not aware about the provisions of Hindu Marriage Act

	and later coming to know about the legal provisions he	
	filed a matrimonial suit, being MAT Suit No. 10 of 2005,	
	before the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge,	
	Fast Track Court-IV, Krishnanagar praying for a decree of	
	divorce from his first wife. By a judgement delivered on	
	28 <sup>th</sup> June, 2010 it was dismissed. On 17 <sup>th</sup> June, 2011 he	
	registered his second marriage with Jamuna Pal under	
	the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. It has been stated in	
	paragraph 6.9 of the application that in the Service Book	
	he had nominated his second wife as his nominee. On	
	coming to know about such information, the first wife by	
	a letter dated 27 <sup>th</sup> July, 2016 made a representation to	
	the Commandant for making necessary correction in the	
	Service Book by making her the only nominee. The	
	applicant after having superannuated submits that since	
	he has retired and no steps have been taken to disburse	
	pensionary benefits, appropriate order may be passed for	
	disbursing pension.	
	On a query, Mr. Mitra, learned advocate for	
	the applicant submits that departmental proceedings	
	have been initiated against his client on the last date of	
	his retirement. It is orally submitted by Mr. Mitra that	
	pending departmental proceedings, provisional pension

	Mr. Banerjee, learned advocate on behalf of	
	the State submits that as departmental proceedings are	
	continuing and since the petitioner has married again	
	which is not permissible under the provisions of the	
	Hindu Marriage Act, he is not entitled to get regular	
	pension. However, since the applicant on 7 <sup>th</sup> June, 2018	
	has filed an application before the Commandant for grant	
	of regular pension, the Commandant by a memo dated	
	28 <sup>th</sup> June, 2018 has sent the necessary papers for grant of	
	provisional pension in accordance with law to the	
	Principal Accountant General (A & E) West Bengal,	
	Kolkata . Copies of such documents filed by Mr. Banerjee	
	be kept on record.	
	Having heard the learned advocate for the	
	parties and considering the facts and circumstances of	
	this case, in our view since the departmental proceedings	
	have been initiated during the service period of the	
	applicant, no order can be passed as prayed for in the	
	application. However, as an application has been filed by	
	the applicant for grant of provisional pension and since it	
	has been forwarded by the Commandant to the	
	appropriate authority , the authorities are at liberty to
