Koley, Advocates.</p> <p>In this application, the applicant claiming to have joined in the establishment of Deputy Controller of Civil Defence, North sub-area on 1st October, 1966 as staff officer Instructor and subsequently promoted to the post of WBCS (Executive) cadre on 15th October, 1980, has prayed for a direction upon the respondents to count his service period from 1st October, 1966 to 14th October, 1980 in the Civil Defence department by reconstructing his service book and to send the original service book after reconstructing it to the District Magistrate, Uttar Dinajpur, – the respondent no. 5, being the authority to sanction retiral dues. It appears from the statements made in the application that certain criminal proceedings were initiated against the applicant.
