	respondents for cancellation of notification dated	
	November 27, 2017 issued by the Finance Department,	
	Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal by which	
	remuneration of Part-Time Sweepers (nomenclature	
	changed as Karmabandhu) was enhanced from Rs.	
	2000/- to Rs. 3000/- per month w.e.f. January 01,	
	2018.	
	The contention of the applicants is that they were	
	engaged as Water Carrier-cum-Sweeper in the	
	establishment of different offices under District Land &	
	Land Reforms Officer, North 24-Parganas in the year	
	1992. Learned Counsel representing the applicants	
	contends that the applicants are contractual employees	
	working in the establishments under District Land &	
	Land Reforms Officer, North 24-Parganas throughout all	
	working days in every month and thereby they are	
	entitled to get remuneration in terms of Memorandum

	Representative of the State Respondents contends that	
	the applicants are not Casual/Daily Rated/Contractual	
	employees engaged in any government establishment	
	for the purpose of getting benefit in terms of	
	Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011	
	issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch,	
	Government of West Bengal.	
	Having heard Learned Counsel for the applicants	
	and the Departmental Representative of the state	
	respondents, we find from Annexure $P_3$ to the original	
	application that the applicants were engaged as Water	
	Carrier-cum-Sweeper on monthly remuneration not	
	exceeding Rs. 700/- per month. No order of engagement	
	of the applicants in the establishments under District	
	Land & Land Reforms Officer, North 24-Parganas as	
	Casual/Daily Rated/Contractual employees is	
	forthcoming before the Tribunal. In the absence of	
	production of order of engagement of the applicants	
	either as casual employees or daily rated employees or	
	contractual employees, we are constrained to hold on	
	the basis of remuneration received by the applicants as	
	reflected in Annexure $P_3$ that the applicants have been

dated November 27, 2017 issued by the Finance	
Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal,	
by which monthly remuneration of part-time Sweepers	
(nomenclature changed as Karmabandhu) was	
enhanced from Rs. 2,000/- per month to Rs. 3,000/-	
per month w.e.f. January 01, 2018. In view of our	
above observation, we are unable to accept the	
contention made on behalf of the applicants that they	
will not be governed by Memorandum dated November	
27, 2017 issued by the Finance Department, Audit	
Branch, Government of West Bengal.	
As a result, the present application is <b>dismissed</b> .
