By producing copy of letter dated August 21, 2017 issued by the Additional Treasury Officer, Chandernagore Treasury in favour of Respondent No. 2 (c), Mr.Ray, Learned Counsel representing the State Respondents submits that the pension of the applicant has already been revised to Rs. 12,238/- per month plus dearness relief w.e.f. April 1, 2009. Since the pension of the applicant has already been revised and the said revised pension along with dearness relief is being released in favour of the applicant, we do not find any merit in the present application.
