The contention of the applicant is that the applicant participated in the selection process for recruitment to the post of Warder in the Correctional Home in the year 2000. The further contention of the applicant is that the applicant was successful in Physical Measurement Test and Field Test and also in the Written Test, but his name did not appear in the list of successful candidates. On consideration of the documents available on record, we have found that the applicant qualified in Physical Measurement Test and Field Test and appeared in the Written Examination. It is pertinent to point out that the Written Examination conducted only for those candidates, who did not pass Matriculation or Madhyamik Examination. The applicant did not pass Madhyamik Examination and as such, he appeared in written examination, but he failed in the said examination. No document is forthcoming from the side of the applicant before the Tribunal to indicate that the applicant was called for the interview after the Written Examination. Since the applicant did not pass Written Examination, his name was not included in the list of selected candidates for appointment to the post of Warders in the Correctional Home.</p> <p>In view of our above findings, we do not find any merit in the present application. As a result, the original application is dismissed.</p>
