On our query, Mrs. Mitra submits that the applicant has not made any calculation about the amount of arrears of salary to be received by him. Since the applicant is not aware of the amount of arrears of salary to be received by him during the period from April 01, 1997 to February 28, 2006, and since arrears of salary to the tune of Rs. 1,23,279/- have already been disbursed in favour of the applicant, we are of the view that the state respondents have disbursed the amount of arrears of salary claimed by the applicant.</i></p> <p><i>In view of our above observation, the original application stands <b>disposed of</b>.</i></p> <p><b>S.
