	applicant worked as Tahasil Moharar under Tahasildar as	
	seasonal worker before his appointment as Night Guard	
	in the regular post and as such, the period of service	
	rendered by the applicant as seasonal worker can never	
	be considered for counting of past service in order to give	
	retirement benefits to the applicant. We fully agree with	
	the submission made on behalf of the State Respondents.	
	In view of our above findings, we cannot	
	persuade ourselves to give any direction to the State	

Respondents to consider the prayer of the applicant for

granting pension as per provision of Rule 67 of West
