	The instant application has been filed	
	mainly challenging the appellate authority's order dated

	During the second of bearing the	
	During the course of hearing, the	
	counsel for the applicant has submitted that the	
	applicant was punished by the disciplinary authority vide	
	order dated 17.04.2012 whereby he has been punished	
	with forfeiture of consecutive two years increment	
	having future effect. Being aggrieved with the	
	punishment, the applicant has preferred one appeal	
	before the appellate authority. However, the appellate	
	authority without granting him any opportunity by way of	
	issuing any show cause notice has enhanced the	
	punishment by way of forfeiture of annual increment for	
	consecutive five years without future effect. According to	
	the applicant, this is clear instance of violation of natural	
	justice as he has not got any opportunity to make proper	
Page /1	submission with regard to such enhanced punishment.	

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15	Therefore, counsel for the applicant has prayed for	
13.12.2018	quashing of the appellate order dated 10.08.2012 only.	
	However, the counsel for the respondent has	
	submitted that there is no such provision in the rule to	
	grant him any opportunity under Rule 884 of PRB part- I.	
	However, the counsel for the applicant has submitted	
	that as per Regulation 884 of PRB, there is specific	
	provision of opportunity before the proposed enhanced	
	punishment.	
	In support of the contention the applicant has	
	prayed for quashing of the order.	
	prayed for quashing of the order.	
	Heard the parties and perused the record. It	
	is noted that during the course of hearing, counsel for the	
	applicant has already prayed for quashing of appellate	
	authority's order since it is a clear case of violation of	
	natural justice as per the applicant.	
	In view of the above, as the applicant is not	
	present, we quash and set aside the appellate order	
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<u>15</u> 13.12.2018	dated 10.08.2012 and remand back the matter to the appellate authority with a direction to grant the applicant appropriate opportunity and to pass an appropriate order and communicate the same to the applicant within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the order. With the above observation and direction the application is disposed of.
