The contention of the applicant is that she is the wife of Late Gopal Das alias Gopal Chandra Das who retired from service on August 31, 2013 after working as O.P. Grade-I under Respondent No. 2, District Land &amp; Land Reforms Officer, South 24 Paraganas. The grievance of the applicant is that the representation submitted by the applicant through her Learned Advocate before the Respondent No. 2 on August 24, 2016 has not been considered by the said respondent and the family pension of the applicant has not yet been decided by the said respondent.</p> <p>Mr.S.Bhattacharya, the authorised representative of the State Respondents has produced copy of Single</p>	

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	<p>Comprehensive Form filled up by the deceased Gopal Chandra Das for the purpose of pension and family pension and submitted that the deceased employee has categorically mentioned that he has no family. He further submits that the deceased employee has mentioned in the column 4 of Single Comprehensive Form that there is no person to receive family pension.</p> <p>In view of the grievance of the applicant that her representation has not been considered by the Respondent No. 2 till date and the claim of the applicant that she happens to be the wife of the deceased Gopal Chandra Das, we direct the Respondent No. 2, District Land &amp; Land Reforms Officer, South 24 Paraganas to consider the representation submitted by the applicant through her Learned Advocate on August 24, 2016 (Page No. 24 of the original application) in accordance with law after giving the applicant an opportunity of hearing within a period of 12 weeks from the date of communication of the order.</p>
